Directors' Report pursuant to Prospects Rule 4.11.12 for the period 1 January 2018 to 30 June 2018

This Half-Yearly Report is being published in terms of Chapter 4 of the Prospects Rules of the Malta Stock Exchange and the Prevention of Financial Markets Abuse Act, 2005. The Half-Yearly Report comprises the reviewed (not audited) condensed consolidated interim financial statements for the six months ended 30 June 2018 prepared in accordance with IAS 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting'. The condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been reviewed in accordance with the requirements of ISRE 2410, 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity'. The comparative Statement of Financial Position has been extracted from the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2017.

Principal activity

Klikk Finance p.l.c. (formerly BOE Finance Limited) (the Company) is the financing arm of the Group and its main purpose is to act as financer of the subsidiary, Klikk Limited (the Subsidiary).

The principal activity of the Subsidiary relates to the business of IT products as well as software development. The Subsidiary operates two stores, one in the Birkirkara By-Pass and the other in Tal-Barrani Road, Zejtun. Furthermore, the Subsidiary develops Bespoke and B2B software solutions for corporate customers.

Review of business and results

The Group (consisting of the Company and the Subsidiary) incurred a consolidated loss before tax of €95,015 (2017: €233,547) for the six-month period ended 30 June 2018, a decrease of 59% over the previous period.

Progress has been registered following the Bond issue, as turnover increased from €1.5m between January to June 2017 to €2.4m between January to June 2018, representing an increase of 58%. Moreover, the Group's gross profit margin increased to 26.0% during this period (January to June 2017: 21.9%).

Dividend

No interim dividends are being proposed.

Introduction

Notes to the Interim Condensed Consolidated Financial Statements for the period 1 January 2018 to 30 June 2018

1. Corporate information

The interim condensed consolidated financial statements of Klikk Finance plc and its subsidiaries ('the Group') for the six months ended 30 June 2018 were authorized for issue in accordance with a resolution of the Board of Directors on 21 August 2018.

Klikk Finance plc ('the Company') is a limited liability company incorporated in Malta, under the Companies Act, Cap. 386 of the Laws of Malta.

2. Basis of preparation and principal accounting policies

2.1 Basis of preparation

The interim condensed consolidated financial statements for the six months ended 30 June 2018 have been prepared in accordance with International Accounting Standard IAS 34 "Interim Financial Reporting".

The interim condensed consolidated financial statements do not include all the information and disclosures required in the annual financial statements, and should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual financial statement as at 31 December 2017, which have been prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards as adopted by the European Union.

2.2 New standards, interpretations and amendments adopted by the Group

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the interim condensed consolidated financial statements are consistent with those followed in the preparation of the Group's annual consolidated financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2017, except for the adoption of new standards effective as of 1 January 2018. The Group has not early adopted any other standards, interpretation or amendment that has been issued but is not yet effective.

The nature and the effect of these changes are disclosed below. Although these amendments apply for the first time in 2018, they do not have material impact on the interim condensed consolidated financial statements of the Group. The nature and the impact of each amendment is described below:

IFRS 15 Revenue from Contracts with Customers

IFRS 15 supersedes IAS 11 Construction Contracts, IAS 18 Revenue and related Interpretations and it applies to all revenue arising from contracts with customers, unless those contracts are in the scope of other standards. The new standard establishes a five-step model to account for revenue arising from contracts with customers. Under IFRS 15, revenue is recognised at an amount that reflects the consideration to which an entity expects to be entitled in exchange for transferring goods or services to a customer.

The standard requires entities to exercise judgement, taking into consideration all of the relevant facts and circumstances when applying each step of the model to contracts with their customers. The standard also specifies the accounting for the incremental costs of obtaining a contract and the costs directly related to fulfilling a contract.

The Group applied the amendments prospectively using the modified approach. However, their application has no effect on the Group's financial position and performance as the Group, reassessment is to be made as at year end for the effect of this standard to the Group's financial statements.

Notes to the Interim Condensed Consolidated Financial Statements for the period 1 January 2018 to 30 June 2018

IFRS 9 Financial Instruments

IFRS 9 Financial Instruments replaces IAS 39 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018, bringing together all three aspects of the accounting for financial instruments: classification and measurement; impairment; and hedge accounting.

The Group has applied IFRS 9 prospectively, with the initial application date of 1 January 2018.

Several other amendments and interpretations apply for the first time in 2018, but do not have an impact on the interim condensed consolidated financial statements of the Group.

3. Use of judgements and estimates

In preparing condensed consolidated interim financial statements, the Board of Directors have made judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expense. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The significant judgements made by management in applying the Group's accounting policies and the key sources of estimation uncertainty were the same as those that applied to the consolidated financial statements as at 31 December 2017.

4. Segment information

For management purposes, the Group is organized into business units based on its products and services and has two reportable segments, as follows:

The Lending and Financing and Retail segment includes financing of debtors and the retail of IT products and electronic goods, including but not limited to laptops, desktops, smartphones, tablets, television and computer peripheral devices.

In addition, the Group also offers be-spoke software solutions. Klikk Limited supplies its computer products and services mainly to individuals, corporate customers and Government institutions and Departments. Customers may acquire the products and/or software either through cash sale or on credit as secured by the bills of exchange.

Management monitors the operating results of its business units separately for the purpose of making decisions about resource allocation and performance assessment. Segment performance is evaluated based on profit or loss and is measured consistently with profit or loss in the consolidated financial statements.

Transfer prices between operating segments are on an arm's length basis in a manner similar to transactions with third parties.

Inter-segment revenues are eliminated upon consolidation and reflected in the 'adjustment and eliminations' column.
